Chairman Dave Devine handed the meeting over to John McKinnon the newly elected Club President.

General Business

Dave Devine gave thanks to Tony Pritchard and nominated that he be made a life member of the club. Deb Teakel seconded the motion and it was voted in by all members.

Mary Selby questioned why the original name boards were not being displayed on the club walls, as there is history going back to 1968 that should be put up that was donated by families to the club. John McKinnon replied that once the club renovations were completed in the clubrooms, a rail system was to be put in place along the walls, so that the boards can be returned.

Jim Winrow questioned whether there would be a junior coaching co-ordinator in place this year and what was happening with junior and senior coaches this year. John McKinnon said that he would be overseeing the Small Sided Games again next year and that Gordon Robson would take on the junior development of ages 11 to 16, while the senior coaches positions had been advertised for next season and Tony Maguire was in place for the Saturdays. There is to be a junior coaches meeting on Tuesday 26th October to gauge which coaches are returning next season, with junior trials to be held in November/December this year.

Jim said he was pleased with the performances of the juniors and thought that having the SSG kids doing ball boys at the seniors games was a good idea and should be encouraged again. He said that the 1st team players should get more involved in the junior training.

Ron Costanzo brought up that as the committee is a lot smaller this year than last and that the work rate will be doubled, that support was needed from members, eg Saturday games - with help in setting up, gates, tickets, etc.

John McKinnon said that the Gosnells Council has put out to tender for the works in the clubrooms and once selected they will begin work in 4-5 weeks, with a completion date of 26 weeks. The clubroom will be partitioned off once the internal work begins, with a meeting required with the selected tender prior to commencement of these works. The electrical contractors have been into the club to have a look and again, once selected a meeting will be required to note work and timings. Ossie said that the club needs to see if portable toilets are required over this period, as there may be private functions booked into the club and check if those people still want to hire the clubroom with the disruption going on.
