CODE OF CONDUCT

The Gosnells City Football Sporting and Social Club as a commitment:

- To refuse service to intoxicated persons. Bar Staff will not serve any intoxicated person or any person to intoxication. Any intoxicated person will be asked to leave the premises and provision will be made to ensure their safe return home.
- To discourage disorderly behaviour and ensure that juveniles are under the control of a responsible person. To ensure the care of patrons by providing water, soft drinks and low alcohol beer and the availability of food to patrons.
- To deal with any complaints from patrons or nearby residents in a polite and professional manner. A Refusal and Incident Book is located behind the bar for the recording of such occurrences.
- To encourage patrons to respect the rights of neighbours by not playing music at an excessive level and by vacating the clubrooms and carpark in a quiet and orderly manner.
- To adopt responsible server practices by ensuring ongoing training for bar staff, provided by the bar manager (who has successfully completed their manager training). Bar staff shall not be permitted to drink alcohol and drinking contests and multiple drink orders will not be permitted.
- To being a club that is responsible and liable for the conduct and behaviour of its supporters, whether home or away matches.
- Each Patron at a match must comply with the Football Federation Australia Spectator Code of Behaviour. It is the host Club's responsibility to ensure the FFA Spectator Code of Behaviour is implemented and enforced against all spectators.
- A guest club is liable for improper conduct among its own group of supporters. Supporters occupying the guest sector of a stadium are regarded as the guest Club's supporters, unless proven to the contrary.
